For mine I did some embroidery using the BERNINA #43 Free motion cording foot. This foot can be used in embroidery like I have, or you can use it for free motion quilting on any BERNINA Sewing machine. I also used La Espiga Nylon Cording. For this technique I used an embroidery machine, specifically in my photos I am using the Bernina B500 Embroidery only machine.

I have fusible fleece fused onto my triangles for extra stabilization, as well as using a tear away stabilizer in the hoop when embroidering.

The Embroideries I purchased off of www.embroideryonline.com I searched for a Quilting embroidery design.

THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT...When cording with an embroidery you NEED a single run embroidery design. This will keep the cording from bunching up.

Once the embroidery was done I assembled as per the instructions on the website linked above. I did add a sand bag in the bottom for a little extra weight.

I also put sand in the front lip, (Where the gingerbread men are) so I can put pins in there!
